

Arthur Miller's "Death of a Salesman," while confusing when just read through the text alone, is an awesomely crafted play that takes drama to the next level. Reading something like this makes me believe that I can some up with something great too. I am glad that I finally took the time to read it. The story is about a broken-hearted salesman, Willy Loman.
