

I read this book cover to cover in 10 minutes. Sure, this is a book of Haiku but, that's not why I read it in 10 minutes. I can't get enough of Tyler Knott Gregson's words. He's so eloquent. He's incredibly talented. The photos that he takes, the words he writes... they touch something deep in your soul & make you feel everything he's writing about. Feeling the depth of love in 3 lines is incredible. I love his writings. If you've read his first book, Chasers of the Light, you will love this.
